Euronext is the leading pan-European exchange, covering Belgium, France, Ireland, The Netherlands, Norway, Portugal and the UK. With close to 1,500 listed issuers worth €4.5 trillion in market capitalisation as of end December 2019, Euronext has an unmatched blue chip franchise that includes 26 issuers in the Morningstar® Eurozone 50 IndexSM and a strong diverse domestic and international client base. Euronext operates regulated and transparent equity and derivatives markets and is the largest centre for debt and funds listings in the world. Its total product offering includes Equities, FX, Exchange Traded Funds, Warrants & Certificates, Bonds, Derivatives, Commodities and Indices. Euronext also leverages its expertise in running markets by providing technology and managed services to third parties. In addition to its main regulated market, Euronext also operates Euronext GrowthTM and Euronext AccessTM, simplifying access to listing for SMEs. The Norwegian stock exchange and its clearing & settlement subsidiary, together operating as Oslo Børs VPS, joined Euronext on 17 June 2019.

Listing

Within Euronext, the Listing Department is in charge of the relationship with listed companies and those contemplating an IPO. Our mission is to promote financial markets and explain to business leaders the benefits of listing and how to better use financial markets once public. In addition, we are fully supporting the funding mechanics by creating and promoting new services and financing instruments, fostering the development and growth of the investors pool, gathering the ecosystem and lobbying towards European public authorities. Proximity with business leaders and members of the ecosystem is essential for our success. In addition to a strong presence of the Listing team in Paris, Brussels, Amsterdam and Lisbon, local representations have been set up in major French cities (Bordeaux, Lyon, Marseille and Nantes) and most recently in new European locations: Frankfurt, Madrid, Milan, Munich and Zurich. After the acquisition of the Irish Stock Exchange in 2017, Euronext announced the acquisition of Oslo Børs VPS in 2018, further extending its European footprint and reinforcing its pivotal position towards capital markets convergence in Europe.

Key Accountabilities

The Listings Analyst will have responsibility for structuring, developing and delivering highly impacting commercial material and product development initiatives for the Listing department Euronext's strategic initiatives (SMEs, Tech, ESG, etc.). To do so, he/she will closely work with a virtual and transversal team across Listing topics at group level, supported by central resources in statistics and public affairs.

The Listings Analyst, he/she will be a decisive support and a full member of the Listing team in the development and day-to-day activities across Europe (circa €50m of annual revenues). He/she will carry out research, conduct studies and produce cutting-edge intelligence for the Listing business with a focus on Belgium and The Netherlands while working with France, Portugal, Ireland, Norway and other European countries.

The position requires him/her to identify and work with key stakeholders to ensure alignment with business objectives and company-wide consistency. Under the direction of the Head of Analysts, the Listings Analyst will be responsible for :

- Developing and producing market intelligence to support the team's efforts in expanding the Listing business
- Supporting the global and local teams with the preparation of their meetings and presentation materials
- Structuring and preparing quarterly reports and presentations on market activity from a Listing perspective
- Realizing strategic watch at both the competitors (primary and secondary markets deals benchmarking) and priority areas (SMEs, Tech, ESG, etc.) levels
- Endorsing ownership of all materials published on Listing activity (reports, press releases, articles etc.) and liaising with the press, marketing and public affairs teams, whether in a proactive or reactive mode (including management of inbound and outbound intelligence public bodies, associations, financial community, etc.)
- Assisting in the design and roll-out of strategic initiatives targeting prospects, issuers and ecosystem members for Listing

The candidate will be a dynamic and high-potential finance professional with a track record of working with various stakeholders, understanding capital markets mechanics and related analysis, as well as working on projects in a multi-national environment.
